COOKIE POLICY

- 1.1. KARM Legal Consultants PVT Limited ("KARM" or "Firm") digital platform including our website (the "Website") uses cookies. This Cookie Policy ("Policy") explains how we use cookies and similar technology and your choice options in this regard. This Policy shall be read in conjunction with our Privacy Policy, Terms and Conditions and all other Website policies. Please read this carefully as this Policy is legally binding when you access or use the Website, regardless of how you access or make use of the Website and our services.
- 1.2. We may use cookies and similar technologies that automatically collect certain information from your browser or device when you visit the Website, read our emails, use our services or otherwise engage with us.

2. WHAT IS A COOKIE

2.1. A cookie is a piece of data contained in a very small text file that is stored in your browser or elsewhere in your hard drive. We use cookies, web beacons, log files, and a variety of similar technologies (collectively, "cookies") to collect information from your browser or device and evaluate the effectiveness of our Website and analyses user trends. These technologies collect information about how you use our service (e.g., the pages you view, the links you click, and other actions you take on the Website), information about your browser and online usage patterns (e.g., Internet Protocol ("IP") address, browser type, browser language, referring / exit pages and URLs, pages viewed, whether you opened an email, links clicked), and information about the device(s) you use to access the Website and our services (e.g., mobile device identifier, mobile carrier, device type, model and manufacturer, mobile device operating system brand and model, and whether you access the Website from multiple devices). Cookies are useful because they allow a website to recognize your device. Cookies allow you to navigate between pages efficiently, remember preferences and generally improve the user experience. Cookies could also be used to tailor advertising to your interests through tracking your browsing across different websites.

3. WHY DO WE USE THESE TECHNOLOGIES

3.1. We may use the information collected through these technologies to better display our Website, deliver content (including ads), recognise you to save you time and access to customised features, track your specified preferences, to provide better technical support including certain Website features, for promotional purposes, and to measure and analyze Website's usage. We may also use third-party service providers and said service providers may place cookies on the hard drive of your device (or use similar technologies) and will receive information on how our users navigate and use the Website.

4. TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

We may use cookies which will not be saved on your device, or which will only be saved on your device for as long as your browser is active (session cookies) and those which will be saved on your device for a longer period (persistent cookies). We take appropriate security measures to prevent unauthorized access to our cookies.

5. USE OF IP ADDRESSES AND WEB LOGS

- 5.1. We may also use your IP address and browser type to help diagnose problems with our Website's server, to administer our Website, and to improve the service we offer to you. An IP address is a numeric code that identifies your computer on the internet. Your IP address might also be used to gather broad demographic information.
- 5.2. We may perform IP lookups to determine which domain you are coming from (e.g., google.com) to more accurately gauge our users' demographics.
- 5.3. Information from these types of cookies and technologies is not combined with information about you from any other source and will not personally identify you.

6. ADVERTISEMENTS

6.1. Where we use third-party advertising companies to serve ads when you visit or use our Website. These companies may use information about your visits to our Website and other websites that are contained in web cookies and other tracking technologies in order to provide advertisements about goods and services of interest to you, provided you have consented to the same.

7. LINKS TO THIRD-PARTIES

7.1. Our services, Website, or communications may contain links to other third-party websites which are not owned or operated by us and are regulated by their own policies. We strongly advise you to review the policies of every website you visit. We specifically recommend that you, as the user (under this Policy) visit, familiarize, and understand the cookie policies of such entities, as they are our partners in providing services to you.
